

ORDINANCE NO. 766

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7-6, OF THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED "RUN-OFF ELECTIONS REQUIRED" PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 508; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, that Chapter 7, Section 7-6, of the DeFuniak Springs, Florida, Municipal Code, entitled "Run-off Elections Required" pursuant to Ordinance 508 is hereby repealed in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

"No candidate shall be elected to a city office unless he has received a majority of the votes cast for his office at the election. If no candidate for a particular office receives a majority of the votes cast in his office there shall be a run-off election between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for a particular office on the annual election date; said run-off election shall be held on the third Tuesday after the annual election date with the candidate receiving the highest number of votes in the run-off election being elected to the office. All laws and regulations not in conflict with this section which relate to the election procedures to be followed on election day shall apply to the run-off election"

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
