

RESOLUTION 2008-08

**WHEREAS**, the above legislation would limit cities' abilities to perform in-house projects using city personnel and inmate labor; and

**WHEREAS**, cities have faced revenue reductions due to property tax reform and have less funds available today than two years ago to provide services to city residents and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of DeFuniak Springs performs in-house repair and maintenance on public facilities at a great cost savings to our tax paying citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of DeFuniak Springs, like other cities across Florida, look for ways to save taxpayer dollars and provide quality services that enhance our community.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of DeFuniak Springs, opposes House Bill 683 and Senate Bill 2148 and request that the Legislators representing the City of DeFuniak Springs oppose this legislation.
