Whereas, The University of West Florida, Askew Institute and the Florida Public Archeology Network are seeking to designate the Florida panhandle as a National Heritage Area, and

Whereas, City of DeFuniak Springs is replete with natural and historic resources, and

Whereas, this designation co-insides with the city's desire to develop economically in a number of ways including historic and cultural tourism, becoming an elderly friendly city and by seeking small business and industry, and


Whereas, the city's historic district, listed in the National Register of Historic Places contains 264 structures as contributing sites and two structures listed as independent sites on the register,

Be it therefore resolved, that the city fully supports all efforts to designate the area as a National Heritage Area and


