Historic Interpretive Panels


Christopher Mitchell, DeFuniak Springs grant coordinator, presented the three submittals received for the historic interpretive panels project throughout the original grounds of the Florida Chautauqua resort/campus for self-guided tours. Mitchell indicated the city had advertised for request for bids for the project and opened on February 1, 2019. The three submittals were from londesign for \$45,000 with no installation; Arete Industries for \$36,082 with installation; and Conservation by Design for \$45,460 with installation.

Discussion occurred relating to the differences between the submittals of londesign and Arete Industries.

Councilman Kelley made a motion to award the contract to Arete Industries for an amount of \$36,082, seconded by Councilman Wright. Councilwoman Griffith: Aye; Councilman Wright: Aye; Councilman Kelley: Aye; Councilman Graham: Aye; **Motion carried 4-0.**

There being no further business, Mayor Campbell adjourned the special meeting at 5:55 p.m.
