

ORDINANCE NO. 903

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6.5, ARTICLE II, SECTION 6.5-17 OF THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "WAIVER OF FEES" AND CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 16-26 OF THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "WAIVER OF FEES" AND CHAPTER 6.5, ARTICLE III, SECTION 6.5-32 OF THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "WAIVER OF FEES" PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED AND ENACTED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCES 481, 545, 687, AND 782, REPEALING, IN PART, AND SUPERSEDING THOSE ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, that Chapter 6.5, Article II, Section 6.5-17 of the DeFuniak Springs, Florida Municipal Code Entitled "Waiver of Fees"; and Chapter 16, Article IV, Section 16-26 of the DeFuniak Springs, Florida Municipal Code Entitled "Waiver of Fees" and Chapter 6.5, Article III, Section 6.5-32 of the DeFuniak Springs, Florida Municipal Code Entitled "Waiver of Fees" adopted and enacted pursuant to Ordinances 481, 545, 687, and 782, and are hereby amended, in part, to create a new subsection C within each Section, and thereby repealing and superseding, in part, all prior ordinances referenced herein in, with said amendment as follows:

1.) Chapter 6.5, Article II, Section 6.5-17 Entitled "Waiver of Fees" is hereby amended to create a new subsection C, to read as follows:

C. All other waivers of fees not provided for in this Section, or otherwise provided for in Chapter 6.5, Article II, Section 6.5-20, Entitled "Special agreements and requests", may be considered and thereafter granted or denied, in whole or in part, by the City Manager, in consultation with the Mayor, provided, however, that the ultimate determination, including factors considered in making said determination shall be reduced to writing, and signed by both the Mayor and the City Manager, and

2.) Chapter 6.5, Article III, Section 6.5-32. Entitled "Waiver of Fees" is hereby amended to create a new subsection C, to read as follows:

C. All other waivers of fees not provided for in this Section, or otherwise provided for in Chapter 6.5, Article II, Section 6.5-35, Entitled "Special agreements", may be considered and thereafter granted or denied, in whole or in part, by the City Manager, in consultation with the Mayor, provided, however, that the ultimate determination, including factors considered in making said determination shall be reduced to writing, and signed by both the Mayor and the City Manager, and

3.) Chapter 16, Article IV, Section 16-26. Entitled "Waiver of Fees" is hereby amended to create a new subsection C, to read as follows:


C. All other waivers of fees not provided for in this Section, or otherwise provided for in Chapter 6.5, Article II, Section 6.5-29, Entitled "Special requests and agreements", may be considered and thereafter granted or denied, in whole or in part, by the City Manager, in consultation with the Mayor, provided, however, that the ultimate determination, including factors considered in making said determination shall be reduced to writing, and signed by both the Mayor and the City Manager.

4.) Ordinances 481, 545, and 782, previously adopted and enacted pertaining to these sections of the code are hereby repealed in part, and superseded, to the extent that the language provided for herein is now to be created in addition to any language existing within the Municipal Code that is not hereby expressly removed.


5.) This Ordinance shall be deemed controlling over any and all previous ordinance, resolution, law, or policy of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida in the event a conflict exists, and to the extent that the provisions of this Ordinance conflict with any law of the State of Florida or the United States of America, or is deemed to be unlawful at any time, the provisions in such conflict or violation shall be deemed severed, with the remaining provisions continuing in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
