

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7-6, OF THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED "RUN-OFF ELECTIONS REQUIRED" PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 766; REPEALING ORDINANCE 766; AND PROVIDING AN AFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, that Chapter 7, Section 7-6, of the DeFuniak Springs, Florida, Municipal Code, entitled "Run-off Elections Required", enacted pursuant to Ordinance 766, is hereby repealed in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7-6. Votes required to be elected, no run-off elections required, exceptions for tie elections.

- (a) A candidate shall be elected to a city office upon receiving the highest number of votes cast among all candidates for his office at the election. A majority of votes cast shall need not be obtained.
- (b) No run-off elections shall be required nor held.
- (c) All laws and regulations not in conflict with this section which relate to elections procedures to be followed on a regular or special election day shall also apply to any run-off elections.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
