

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS REGARDING THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS, FLORIDA RURAL ENTERPRISE ZONE.

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council by Resolution 95-07, with an effective date of March 13, 1995, provided for the establishment of a Florida Rural Enterprise Zone in DeFuniak Springs; and

WHEREAS, the nominated area in the City of DeFuniak Springs was designated as a Florida Rural Enterprise Zone (EZ-6601) by the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs Florida Rural Enterprise Zone has been a proven economic benefit to the businesses and residents of the City of DeFuniak Springs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council Members of the City of DeFuniak Springs:

1. The City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, desires to continue participating in the current Florida Enterprise Zone Program.
2. The City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida City Council, finds that the current DeFuniak Springs Rural Enterprise Zone is most beneficial to the businesses and residents of our designed boundary areas.
3. The City of DeFuniak Springs, Florida City Council opposes to the proposed Florida Senate 2012 Senate Bill 588 entitled "The Enterprise Program Zone".
4. The City of DeFuniak Springs City Council urges the Legislature to continue the Rural Enterprise Zone Program in its current form.
