

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS REGARDING THE REQUESTING A BOUNDARY CHANGE FOR THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS RURAL ENTERPRISE ZONE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs City Council by Resolution 95-07, with an effective date of March 13, 1995, provided for the establishment of a Florida Rural Enterprise Zone in DeFuniak Springs; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2011-290, Laws of Florida, the Florida Enterprise Zone Act, requires that a Resolution be passed requesting the reasons for the boundary expansion of the enterprise zone to the State and explaining the reasons and conditions for which the DeFuniak Springs Enterprise Zone merits boundary expansion; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs Enterprise Zone Development Agency Board has adopted Resolution 2012-02 to amend the boundary expansion of the DeFuniak Springs Rural Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs Florida City Council has recommended approval of a boundary amendment to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Division of Community Development upon receipt of all required documentation; and

WHEREAS, the DeFuniak Springs Florida City Council has provided all required documentation to Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Division of Community Development; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of DeFuniak Springs City Council members:

1. The City of DeFuniak Springs Enterprise Zone Development Agency Board and the City of DeFuniak Springs City Council members desire to continue participating in the Florida Rural Enterprise Zone Program.
2. The City of DeFuniak Springs City Council adopts this Resolution in compliance with Chapter 2011-290, Laws of Florida, Florida Enterprise Zone Act, to request a boundary amendment of the City of DeFuniak Springs Florida Rural Enterprise Zone. The nominated area is herein incorporated by the attached map and by reference as Attachment C.
3. The DeFuniak Springs City Council finds that the DeFuniak Springs Rural Enterprise Zone merits boundary expansion, given the area remains in need of economic and social revitalization.
