A RESOLUTION OF DEFUNIAK SPRINGS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE OKALOOSA-WALTON TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION VOTING MEMBERSHIP REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN FOR THE FORT WALTON BEACH-NAVARRE-WRIGHT URBANIZED AREA


WHEREAS, The Okaloosa-Walton Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) has been designated by the Governor as the local agency responsible for carrying out the provisions of Part 23, Section 450.306, Code of Federal Regulations and Chapter 339.175 (2) and (3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Okaloosa-Walton TPO has approved a TPO Voting Membership Reapportionment Plan for the Fort Walton Beach-Navarre-Wright Urbanized Area that adds one (1) additional member from the City of Crestview, adds one (1) additional member from the City of Niceville, and adds one (1) new member from the City of Freeport, decreases two (2) members from Okaloosa County Commission, and decreases one (1) member from the City of Fort Walton Beach and maintains the maximum nineteen (19) members apportioned as follows:

- 3 members of the Okaloosa County Commission,
- 3 members of the Walton County Commission,
- 3 members of the City of Crestview City Council,
- 2 members of the City of Fort Walton Beach City Council,
- 2 members of the City of Niceville City Council,
- 2 members of the City of Destin City Council,
- 1 member of the City of DeFuniak Springs City Council,
- 1 member of the City of Valparaiso City Council;
- 1 member of the Freeport City Council; and
- 1 member of the Mary Esther City Council

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DEFUNIAK SPRINGS CITY COUNCIL THAT The Okaloosa-Walton TPO Voting Membership Reapportionment Plan for the Fort Walton Beach-Navarre-Wright Urbanized Area is hereby accepted and approved and said reapportionment plan shall be submitted to the Governor of Florida for approval.
