



2019 LakeFest Parade and Formation Area

Registration: Intersection of Main Street and Second Avenue - follow parade directional signs. Turn on Bruce Avenue, proceed to 2nd Street (at stop sign), turn left on 2nd Street, proceed to the intersection at Main Street and 2nd Street (just before the train tracks).

PLEASE NOTE: This year's parade will line-up on Main Street along the railroad track, just down from the Presbyterian Church. (same location as this year's GrasFest). The parade will travel counter-clockwise around Circle and will end at the point of origin. PLEASE SEE ATTACHED MAP!

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE PARADE:

- All participants are asked to **check-in**, at the parade registration table, **even if they have pre-registered**. This is the point that parade entry numbers will be given out.
- All floats that wish to be judged for awards, need to be in line no later than noon. Floats will be judged on originality, creativity using the LakeFest theme. Trophies will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners at 12:30 p.m., and the parade rolls at 1 p.m.
- Horse groups, brigades, or posses will line up on College Avenue, one block over from Main Street at the Senior Center where trailers can be unloaded/staged. At 12:45, horses will join the parade route, where they will fall into line-up.
- Please have plenty of candy, throws, beads, etc., that are family friendly, and for any age. You can pass out literature, or business/group/organizational paraphernalia, as long as it does not impede the flow of the parade.
- The parade will line-up on either side of Main Street. Parking for all other non-essential vehicles can park next to the railroad tracks, or down one of the feeder streets along Main Street, as long as no fire hydrant, or driveway is blocked.
