Job Summary:

This position is responsible for all welding for various departments within the city. Typical work schedule will be four days a week from 7 a.m. till 5 p.m.; however, work schedule may vary. Subject to be called in on a holiday or during an emergency.

Essential Job Functions:

- Welds spare parts in various directions: flat, horizontal, vertical or overhead, etc.
- Ignites flame or strikes an arc while welding or performing other electricity-related work to weld part of a metal structure.
- Analyzes defective equipment and any fault in operating equipment and notifies supervisor.
- Clamps, holds, tack-welds, heat-bends, bolts, or grinds spare parts as necessary to satisfy the technical requirements and creates a welded final product.
- Operates accessory equipment and performs tasks necessary for welding metal, such as fusing metal segments, using gas tungsten arc, metal arc, flux-cored arc, plasma arc, and other types of welding arcs.
- Controls the process of fitting, burning, and welding to avoid problems in relation to overheat, distortion, expansion, or shrinking of spare parts.
- Examines finished products and spare parts to verify specifications are met.
- Responsible for preparing and setting up necessary tools and equipment for welding jobs; such as shielded metal arc, gas metal arc, or other welding equipment.
- Arranges and assures welded parts are arranged in order before assembling final products.
- Replaces new and fabricates parts for dump trucks, trailers, heavy equipment, etc.
- Ensures clean weld joint to obtain smooth look.
- Maintains disc grinder and performs all cleaning and grinding of metals.
- Operates various manual and automated welding equipment.
- Analyzes speed and length of welding arc for all welding processes.
- Assembles all components with help of power and hand tools.
- Works in emergency situations and conditions as may be required.
- Adheres to work schedule and attendance requirements.
- Adheres to all safety rules and regulations.
- Performs other duties as directed and required.
- Must create a positive public image as a representative of the city.

Position Qualifications:

High school diploma or GED obtained with basic experience in welding, or any combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and ability to perform the job. Requires a valid driver license and the ability to obtain a class "A" CDL with airbrake endorsements within one (1) year from date of hire. May require inmate supervision certification.
