Job Summary:

This position is an entry level position that assists in the repair, maintenance, construction, and daily operations at the DeFuniak Springs Municipal Airport. Work schedule may vary. Subject to be called in on a holiday or during an emergency situation.

Essential Job Functions:

- Mows, weed-eats, edges grass and pulls and sprays weeds.
- Prunes shrubs and trees.
- Picks up debris to include but not limited to brush, litter, etc.
- Performs landscaping installation and maintenance.
- Performs irrigation installation, operation and repair.
- Performs repairs of fencing and gate installations.
- Performs routine maintenance on mowers and all small engine equipment.
- Performs routine safety inspections and service and repair of all equipment at airport.
- Performs duties of Airport Line Technician as needed.
- Assists any other department when needed as directed by supervisor.
- Adheres to work schedule and attendance requirements.
- Adheres to all safety rules and regulations, including airfield specialty requirements.
- Performs other duties as directed and required.
- Must create a positive public image as a representative of the city.

Required Qualification(s):

High school diploma or GED required. Essential knowledge of grounds maintenance techniques, horticulture, or an equivalent combination of training, education and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and ability to perform the job. Requires a valid driver license with the ability to obtain a class "A" CDL with airbrake endorsements within (1) one year from date of hire. May require inmate supervision certification. May be required to obtain NATA Professional Line Service Training Certification. Ability to obtain pesticide and herbicide applicator license.

An equivalent combination of education, training and experience may be substituted for the minimum requirements.
